1. Grading systems of the institutions

RO TARGU03:

In Romania, marks are given on a scale of 1 to 10.

The following scale is used for all types of evaluations/examinations:

A	10	EXCELENT: outstanding performance with only minor errors
B	9	VERY GOOD: Above the average standard but with some errors
C	7 – 8	GOOD: Generally sound work with a number of notable errors
D	6	SATISFACTORY: Fair but with significant shortcomings
E	5	SUFFICIENT: Performance meets the minimum criteria
FX	4	FAIL: Some more work required before the credit can be awarded
F	1-3	FAIL: Considerable further work is required
